

## **Site Council Minutes October 17, 2016**

Site Council set the dates for their upcoming meetings. The meetings will be held on October 25, November 29, January 24, February 28, April 25, May 23 from 2:30-3:30pm.

There was a proposal that chocolate milk days will be on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays. Site Council approved that request.

Our first family fun night will be on November 17. The focus will be on literacy. The book fair will be operating that night and there will be a pirate theme for the evening. The book fair will be one of the options for a station. The evening will be from 6-7:30pm. Dinner will be one of the stations and we will be serving pasta, salad and bread. Stakeholders will be connecting with their teams and bring back literacy station proposals for our meeting on October 25. Title has some giveaway books that can be distributed however most are intermediate level books. We also discussed ways to collect other books that we might be able to giveaway that evening.

Site Council discussed McCornack's mission statement that was developed last year and approved the draft. We will discuss the core values statement at our meeting on October 25.

Discussion followed regarding the Parent Involvement survey based on our work last year.
