Site Council reviewed our enrollment information and projections. We are projected to be at 362 students. Our kindergarten roundup will be on March 14 from 5:30-6:30pm. The entire Churchill region will be doing kindergarten roundup on the same date and time. We currently are projecting all grade levels at 60 students except for second grade projected at 50 students. The EXPO will help fill vacancies in April and most vacancies will be filled by the end of April.

Read Across America is on March 2 and each student will receive a book to take home. Traditionally the entire school would Drop Everything and Read (DEAR time) for ten minutes, usually at the beginning of the school day. It is also the 100th day of school! Special activities will be at breakfast.

Our Family Fun Science Night will be on Tuesday, March 7. There will be eight stations with hands on activities in the gym and a possible robotics team in the library.
